Imagine Performing Arts starts 2024 with a Home

Imagine Performing Arts presented its first show, Barkley Bigelow's Hullabaloo, in 2014, followed by The Importance of Being Earnest. Since then we have worked with children at the Summer Discovery camps, sponsored Open Mic nights, and collaborated with TV3 on a long-running musical show, in addition to producing other plays.

We did it without a place to call home. Until now.

Connersville Publishing has donated their campus at 406 Central, the longtime home of the News-Examiner and WCNB, to Imagine Performing Arts.

"We're grateful to Connersville Publishing for this generous gift," said Cindy Perez, President of IPA. "We're mindful of this building's rich history, and we look forward to continuing its tradition."

The building has housed multiple businesses and community organizations in the past. The second floor was a theater before it was converted to radio station offices. The Odd Fellows and other lodge groups used to meet on the fourth floor, where there was also a ballroom.

"We'll need to do some renovating right away," Perez stated. "For one thing, there's only one functioning bathroom."

Outbuildings on the property are slated to become scene shop, design and "maker space."
